Hi,

today we would like to tell you everything about Minecraft.

In Minecraft you can choose from 4 different game modes: *Survival, Adventure, Creative* and *Spectator*. In *Survival* mode the goal is to survive in an open world with nothing to start with. There are monsters that want to kill you, but you can kill them too. In *Adventure* mode, you might guess because of its name, you can wander through the open world and explore. In *Creative* mode you can get really creative because you can get an unlimited amount of any building block and fly around. The goal here is to build massive structures. You can use commands to summon different items. In *Spectator* mode you can even go through every block and see the underworld. You can switch between the different game modes in the settings.

How to beat the game:

To beat the *Beat the Game* you will first need to build a Nether Portal, which you will go through. There you need to find a fortress. If you go into it, you can start killing some Blazes. Now you will go back to the *Overworld* to find some *Endermans* to get ender pearls. Now you will craft them together to get *Ender eyes*. You must throw and follow them. They will lead you to the *End*. Once you are in the end, you need to hit the crystals on every tower. If you are done with that, you can kill the dragon with a sword. But to actually win, you need to jump into the portal that opened by killing the dragon.

Like in every game the community has created there are different modifications that you can install in your world. Such as things that help you or things that make it harder for you to win the game. There are also texture packs that change the look of different blocks.

There are two different versions of Minecraft that have features that the other version does not have. One version is called *Bedrocke* and one is called *Java*. For example, in bedrock it is easier to build different automatic farms. In Java fighting is easier.

So hope that you will be curious about the game now and try it out yourselves.
